WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for Electronic Monitoring Program (EMP) services for adult and juvenile probationers whom are on home detention on February 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment on July 1, 2017, to extend the term of the Agreement through June 30, 2018, and to add the Compliance with Living Wage Ordinance language.

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Agreement to increase the agreement amount by \$102,083.25 to an amount not to exceed \$192,083.25, and to extend the term of the Agreement through January 31, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Section 3. Payments</u> of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

 In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed ONE HUNDRED NINETY TWO THOUSAND, EIGHTY THREE DOLLARS AND 25 CENTS (\$192,083.25). In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration.
- Section 4. Term of the agreement is amended to read as follows: Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2015, through January 31, 2019.

All other terms and conditions of the agreement dated February 9, 2016, between the County and the Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.
