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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ARAMARK HEALTHCARE TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, TO PROVIDE BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING AND DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$320,000 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,460,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in August of 2012, the San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) completed a Request for Proposals (RFP) for biomedical engineering and diagnostic imaging maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2012, your Board approved a five-year agreement with Aramark Health Care Technologies, LLC, to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the agreement has been amended multiple times to reflect changes in the inventory equipment list; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2018, SMMC completed an RFP for biomedical and diagnostic imaging maintenance services and is currently in the process of reviewing the proposals; and

WHEREAS, in June 2018, your Board approved an amendment to extend the term through August 31, 2018, and increased the amount by \$140,000 to an amount not to exceed \$4,140,000, to allow SMMC time review the proposals; and

WHEREAS, SMMC is requesting your Board extend the term of the current agreement through December 31, 2018, with an associated increase in funding, to allow SMMC time to review the proposals and execute a new agreement; and

WHEREAS, both parties wish to amend the agreement to extend the term through December 31, 2018 and increase the amount by \$320,000 to an amount not to exceed \$4,460,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such amendment, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
