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**RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BID RECEIVED FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND  
CAPE SEAL OF MADRID AVENUE, SEVILLA AVENUE, AND SONORA AVENUE  
PROJECT IN THE EL GRANADA AREA**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, this Board adopted Resolution No. 075689 on January 23, 2018, which “streamlined” the bid process for projects to be constructed during the 2018 construction season which are maintenance type projects that do not have long lead times for design, are not considered controversial requiring specific property owner input, and that do not require state or federal grant approvals, which have not previously been approved by this Board, or extensive permit approvals from regulatory agencies by authorizing the Director of Public Works to develop plans and specifications and to call for bids for these types of projects; and

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications, dated June 15, 2018, were prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Reconstruction and Cape Seal of Madrid Avenue, Sevilla Avenue and Sonora Avenue Project (Project) and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “Plans and Specifications”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on July 11, 2018, at 2:30 p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Plans and Specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, a single bid submitted by Galeb Paving, Inc. was received for this Project in the amount of \$726,156 based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done, which was referred to the Department of Public Works for analysis and recommendation; and

**WHEREAS**, the overall bid proposal was significantly higher than the Engineer's Estimate of \$486,000 and the Director of Public Works is recommending that the bid be rejected.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** as follows:

1. It is in the best interest of the County to reject the bid for the Reconstruction and Cape Seal of Madrid Avenue, Sevilla Avenue, and Sonora Avenue Project and this Board of Supervisors hereby rejects the bid received on July 11, 2018 for the Reconstruction and Cape Seal of Madrid Avenue, Sevilla Avenue, and Sonora Avenue Project.
2. The Director of Public Works in hereby authorized and directed to proceed with re-advertising the Project for bids.

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
