**RESOLUTION**

**AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “TWO HOUR TIME LIMITED PARKING DURING SPECIFIED HOURS” ZONE, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 12:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M., ON ELMER STREET, IN THE UNINCORPORATED BELMONT AREA**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code section 22507 et al. and Section 7.24.010 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish time limited parking zones and associated signs and markings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “Two-Hour Time Limited Parking During Specified Hours” zone be established as noted herein; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors authorize:

A “Two-Hour, Time Limited Parking During Specified Hours” zone, Monday through Friday, from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. be established at the following location:

- Elmer Street (County Road No. 417) unincorporated Belmont area

Along the southwest side of Elmer Street, 20 feet southeast of the intersection with Karen Road and continuing southeasterly for approximately 250 feet, more or less.
