RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “ONE-HOUR, TIME LIMITED PARKING DURING SPECIFIED HOURS” ZONE, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 8:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M., ON OLD COUNTY ROAD, IN THE UNINCORPORATED BELMONT AREA

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 22507 et al. and Section 7.24.010 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish time limited parking zones and associated signs and markings; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “One-Hour, Time Limited Parking During Specified Hours” zone be established as noted herein; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorize:

. A “One-Hour, Time Limited Parking During Specified Hours” zone, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. be established at the following location:

- Old County Road (County Road No. 21) unincorporated Belmont area

Along the northeast side of Old County Road, 20 feet southeast of the intersection with Karen Road and continuing southeasterly for approximately 100 feet, more or less.
