**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STARVISTA TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES TO CURRENT AND FORMER SAN MATEO COUNTY FOSTER YOUTH, OR YOUNG-ADULTS, FOR THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2019, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$309,000**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the Human Services Agency's ("HSA") Children and Family Services ("CFS") branch works to enhance the well-being of children, adults, and families in San Mateo County by providing professional, responsive, caring, and supportive services; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 8, 2018, HSA conducted a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to identify a provider for employment and educational support services and the StarVista was one of three (3) providers selected, because of their experience and success in providing educational support to foster youth and other marginalized communities in San Mateo County; and

**WHEREAS**, StarVista serves every city in San Mateo County and currently provides some of the most essential services in the County including Healthy Homes; First Chance sobering station; StarVista's homeless and runaway youth programs;

Differential Response; Early Childhood Consultation; and a 24-Hour Crisis Intervention and Suicide and Prevention Center; and

**WHEREAS**, StarVista will provide educational support services that will assist current and former San Mateo County foster youth, and young-adults, in identifying and achieving long term academic goals that will allow them to enhance their education, their employability and their self-sufficiency; and

**WHEREAS**, HSA wishes to enter into an agreement with StarVista for the term of September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$309,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into same.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
