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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SILICON VALLEY CHILDREN'S FUND TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL AND EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT SERVICES TO CURRENT AND FORMER SAN MATEO COUNTY FOSTER YOUTH, OR YOUNG-ADULTS, FOR THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2019, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$240,404

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency's ("HSA") Children and Family Services ("CFS") branch works to enhance the well-being of children, adults, and families in San Mateo County by providing professional, responsive, caring, and supportive services; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2018, HSA conducted a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to identify a provider for employment and educational support services and the Silicon Valley Children's Fund (SVCF) was one of three (3) providers selected, because of their experience and success in providing educational support services in San Mateo County especially through specialized programing; and

WHEREAS, SVCF will provide comprehensive educational support services to San Mateo County foster youth in high school grades 9<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup> through academic planning, coaching and college preparation to a minimum of 35 youth; and

WHEREAS, HSA wishes to enter into an agreement with SVCF for the term of September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019, and in an amount not to exceed \$240,404; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFOERE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
