## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE PUBLIC AUTHORITY RATE AND SUBMISSION OF THE RESOLUTION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, acting as the Governing Board of the San Mateo County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority (PA), that

WHEREAS, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 12301.6(a)(2), the County has established the PA to provide for the delivery of in-home supportive services (IHSS), and the Board of Supervisors of the County has designated itself as the Governing Board of the PA; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Governing Board for its consideration and acceptance a proposal to increase the PA rate; and

WHEREAS, the current combined PA rate for the County, last updated July 1, 2018, is \$16.15 per hours of IHSS services provided; and

WHEREAS, County PA rates are used by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) for its calculation of the State and County-by-County cost estimates of the IHSS program; and

WHEREAS, the PA request to increase to the PA administrative rate from \$0.29 to \$0.45 and an increase to the health benefits (non-locally negotiated) rate of \$0.27

such that the combined PA rate for the County is increased to \$16.58 effective January 1, 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** State authorization to change the PA rate requires submission to the State of a Governing Board resolution approving the new rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that this Governing Board hereby approves submission of this Resolution to the State Department of Social Services for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and that contingent on the State's processing of this documentation, the new combined Public Authority rate for all components is hereby changed to \$16.58 per hour, effective January 1, 2019.
