## The 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the End of World War I

**WHEREAS**, Veterans Day 2018 marks the 100th anniversary of the end of the Great War, a "war to end all wars" that was one of the largest and deadliest conflicts in history; and

**WHEREAS,** major hostilities of World War I came to a halt on the 11<sup>th</sup> hour of the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month of 1918; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Peninsula, including San Mateo County, was active in the war effort; and

**WHEREAS**, through the then-military base Camp Fremont, located within Menlo Park and Palo Alto's borders, where the Army's Eighth Division formed and trained for service in France; and

**WHEREAS,** Camp Fremont's hospital on Willow Road would later become the sight of the Veterans Administration in Menlo Park; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County do hereby proclaim November 11, 2018 as the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War I, which we celebrate as Veterans Day.
