WHEREAS, STEPHANIE WONG, a senior at Mills High School, is a model student who has demonstrated commitment to her community in a variety of ways; and

WHEREAS, STEPHANIE WONG organized the San Mateo March for Our Lives walk to honor the 17 lives lost in the tragic Parkland, Florida, shooting, and has meet with many local legislators to advocate for the creation of a bill adopting stronger measures for the use of 3D printed “ghost guns”; and

WHEREAS, STEPHANIE WONG has served on the American Red Cross Executive Board of Directors as an Officer since August 2016, serving as the West Bay Area Club liaison in 2016 and managing 26 clubs in San Francisco and San Mateo, was named Diversity Coordinator creating a People’s First Language presentation highlighting appropriate terminology addressing individuals with disabilities and access needs, lobbied on behalf of American Red Cross for legislation on veteran services, and taught her peers valuable leadership skills at the annual American Red Cross Leadership Conference.
