Phyllis Jacquay 2018 Veteran of the Year

WHEREAS, Phyllis Jacquay is being honored as the recipient of the 2018 Veteran of the Year award by the San Mateo County Veterans Commission for her dedication to veterans and veteran causes; and

WHEREAS, Phyllis Jacquay served as a nurse in the U.S. Army in Vietnam, rising to the rank of 1st Lieutenant from March 1968 until March 1969; and

WHEREAS, Phyllis Jacquay returned home to work as a registered nurse in St. Louis, Missouri, eventually moving to the Bay Area to continue her nursing career at Kaiser Permanente in Redwood City until she retired in 2001; and

WHEREAS, upon retirement, **Phyllis Jacquay**, with her Midwest values of hard work and helping your neighbor, began to volunteer at the Palo Alto VA Hospital in the Hospice unit, visiting patients who were in the final stages of their lives and providing support and comfort to family members; and

WHEREAS, today **Phyllis Jacquay** continues to give back to veterans as a volunteer at the Menlo Park VA Hospital, where she works with Chaplain services, and as a volunteer with the St. Francis Center in Redwood City, distributing clothing to those most vulnerable; and

***NOW, therefore be it resolved** that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County hereby honors and commends **Phyllis Jacquay**, an unsung hero, for receiving the 2018 Veteran of the Year Award for making an immeasurable impact on the lives of veterans in San Mateo County.*
