BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH MICHAEL BAKER INTERNATIONAL FOR GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS (GIS) SERVICES RELATED TO THE NEW COMPUTER-AIDED DISPATCH SYSTEM FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR, NOT TO EXCEED \$421,650; AND A SOFTWARE SUBSCRIPTION FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE GIS DATA FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS, NOT TO EXCEED \$395,350, WITH THE TOTAL COST FOR BOTH AGREEMENTS NOT TO EXCEED \$817,000 FOR THE FIVE-YEAR TERM, FROM JANUARY 8, 2019 THROUGH JANUARY 7, 2024

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in April of 2015, the Office of Public Safety Communications (PSC) initiated the Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) Replacement Project as the existing system has reached the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, a critical component of a successful CAD system is an accurate set of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data that ensures the closest first responders are dispatched to an emergency incident; and

WHEREAS, the GIS data currently available to Public Safety Communications does not meet the National Emergency Number (NENA) Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG911) standards; and

WHEREAS, GIS data includes important location information such as street center lines, address points and ranges and boundary layers; and

WHEREAS, GIS data must be updated and maintained in order for it to be accurate; and

WHEREAS, an extensive solicitation effort and RFP process was held prior to selecting Michael Baker as the service provider.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors authorize the execution of an agreement with Michael Baker International, Santa Ana California, for GIS services and software subscription related to the Computer Aided Dispatch System.

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
