RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A 'NO PARKING' ZONE IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ON NORTHSIDE AVENUE IN THE NORTH FAIR OAKS, UNINCORPORATED AREA OF REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and section 7.30.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones that prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2009, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolutions No. 070331 and No. 070332 to specify parking restrictions and regulations for 'No Parking' zones on Northside Avenue in the North Fair Oaks unincorporated area of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends extending the existing 'No Parking' zones specified in Resolutions No. 070331 and No. 070332 an additional 55 feet to the easterly edge of the intersection of Hampshire Avenue to support the flow of traffic and for ease of enforcement; and

WHEREAS, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking zone locations, were notified and comments to date are in support of this action; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of

the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the
No Parking Zones be established at the following location:

Northside Avenue (County Road No. 667), North Fair Oaks

On the southerly side of NORTHSIDE AVENUE commencing at a point
252 feet east of the intersection of Warrington Avenue and continuing to
55 feet, more or less, to the easterly edge of the intersection of
Hampshire Avenue.
