**WHEREAS**, SUZANNE AUBRY became the Coordinator Office of Consumer and Family Affairs in 2017, working with BHRS Management and Leadership to bring the voice of consumers and family members to all levels of BHRS operations, and continues to support people with lived experience and the integration of Family Partners and Peer Support Workers into BHRS and county contractor treatment teams.
