BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE ADOPTION OF A COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES PARKING POLICY, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2019; AND B) THE CHIEF OF COUNTY HEALTH, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ISSUE ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES AND/OR CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES PARKING POLICY; AND C) THE CHIEF OF COUNTY HEALTH TO MAKE ADMINISTRATIVE AND NON-SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO THE COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES PARKING POLICY OR UPDATES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a policy to more effectively address and ensure efficient and safe use of parking located at County Health Facilities, and

WHEREAS, State law and local ordinances including, California Vehicle Code Sections 21113 et. al. and 22651.3, and Chapters 1.08, 7.28, and 7.32 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code collectively allow the establishment of parking controls and issuance of citations for parking violations on County-controlled lots; and

WHEREAS, the County Health Facilities Parking Policy will establish various designated parking areas for specific uses as well as no parking areas; and

WHEREAS, violation of the rules or regulations relating to the operation, stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles on the driveways and grounds of County Health Facilities property, duly adopted, and as from time to time amended, by the

County's Board of Supervisors, shall be cited and may result in towing pursuant to the County's parking ordinances and Section 21113 et seq. and Sections 22651 and 22651.3 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, any vehicle parked or left standing in a fire lane, in areas not marked as parking stalls, or in any illegal manner or manner that obstructs traffic will be subject to removal as allowed by the Vehicle Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of County Health recommends the adoption of a County Health Facilities Parking Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that effective February 1, 2019, the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes:

1. The adoption of a County Health Facilities Parking Policy, attached hereto as Attachment A to this resolution.
2. The Chief of County Health, or her designee, to issue administrative penalties and/or citations for violations of the County Health Facilities Parking Policy as allowed by the County Ordinance Code.
3. The Chief of County Health to make administrative changes and non-substantive changes to the County Facilities Parking Policy or updates for compliance with local, state, and Federal regulations.

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
