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### RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE MAXIMUM TERM LENGTH FOR MEASURE K OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE MEMBERS FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS, Measure A** was a ten-year half-cent general sales tax approved by the voters in November 2012; and

**WHEREAS, Measure K**, a 20-year extension of **Measure A**, was approved by the voters in November 2016; and

**WHEREAS, Measure A** required the establishment of a community oversight committee (“Oversight Committee”) “to perform an annual audit of the general fund revenues generated by the Measure; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 13, 2013, the Board created and established the ten-member Oversight Committee and appointed its members to a two-year term; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board, by resolution, provided that Committee members may serve no more than three consecutive two-year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oversight Committee has determined that, in light of the nature of the work performed by the Committee members, the need for continuity on the Committee, and the length of the Measure, it would be beneficial for Committee

members to be authorized to serve up to three consecutive four-year terms, or a maximum of twelve years for members serving an active term as of January 1, 2019, if such appointments are approved by the Board in its sole discretion, and to stagger the terms of service or one-half of the members such that the terms of the Oversight Committee members do not all expire in the same year.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the term length of Oversight Committee members is increased from two years to four years, for no more than three consecutive terms, or a maximum of twelve years.

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
