RESOLUTION: A) AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS IN CONJUNCTION WITH A SPECIAL ALL-MAIL BALLOT ELECTION REGARDING THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF TEN HOUSES AND 23 UNDEVELOPED PARCELS BETWEEN SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 7, 2019; AND B) AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE COSTS FOR SAID ELECTION FROM THE COUNTY'S GENERAL FUND AS REQUIRED BY THE EDUCATION CODE

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools adopted Resolution No. 19-01, giving notice of a special election to be held on May 7, 2019, for the purpose of submitting a territory transfer measure to voters in the La Honda Road Territory (consisting of ten houses and 23 undeveloped parcels of the La Honda Vista Subdivision, as further described in the Resolution), and requesting that the County's Chief Elections Officer render specified election services to the County Superintendent of Schools therefor; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools has requested that its May 7, 2019 election be conducted by way of an all-mail ballot election pursuant to Section 4000 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the special all-mail ballot election to be held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the costs of any election to reorganize school districts shall be paid from the County's General Fund pursuant to Section 35759 of the California Education Code; and

WHEREAS, the County Superintendent of Schools will enter into an agreement with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services for the May 7, 2019 La Honda Road Territory Transfer Special Mail Ballot Election and that the costs of said election shall be charged against the County's General Fund as required by Section 35759 of the Education Code.
