

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERMIT AGREEMENT
No. 5345**

This First Amendment to Permit Agreement ("First Amendment"), dated for reference purposes only as of April 9, 2019, is by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County" or "Permitter"), and NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Permittee").

Recitals

A. As authorized by San Mateo County Resolution No. 71992, County and Permittee entered into a Permit Agreement, dated for reference purposes only as of June 19, 2012 (the "Permit"), which enabled Permittee to use a portion of the San Mateo County Event Center, located at 2495 South Delaware Street, San Mateo, California (the "Property"), consisting of (i) approximately 2,500 square feet of ground space, (ii) one (1) pre-fabricated equipment shelter, (iii) one (1) 70' high monopine, and (iv) the non-exclusive right of access over and through such portions of the Property as is necessary for Permittee's Use (collectively, the "Premises").

B. In connection with use of the Premises, and for the Term of the Permit, Permitter granted Permittee a non-exclusive and non-possessory license co-terminus with the Permit for the placement and use of wiring and conduit.

C. The Permit expired on June 30, 2017, but remains in effect under the holdover provision set forth in Section 26 (Holding Over) of the Permit.

D. County and Permittee desire to amend the Permit to extend the Term, modify the equipment, and increase the Base Permit Fee accordingly.

Agreement

For good and valuable consideration as hereinafter set forth, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Use.** County hereby grants Permittee the right to modify the wireless communication site as shown in the attached plans drawn by Joseph J. Fitzsimons dated June 11, 2018. The project scope will consist of the following:
 - i. Swap (8) Existing Antennas for (8) New Proposed Antennas
 - ii. Swap (4) RRUS 12 B2 with (4) Proposed RRUS 4415 B25 near antennas;
 - iii. Install (2) Proposed Diplexers
 - iv. Install (3) Proposed RRUS 4478 B14 near antennas
 - v. Install (4) Proposed RRUS 4426 B5 near antennas

- vi. Install (4) Proposed RRUS 4478 B5 within existing shelter
- vii. Install (4) Proposed RRUS E2 within existing shelter
- viii. Install (2) Proposed 5216 within existing rack
- ix. Install (4) Proposed XMU within existing rack
- x. Install (1) Proposed Rectifier within existing cabinet
- xi. Remove (8) Existing RRUW (1900) in existing shelter
- xii. Remove (2) Existing DUS41 within existing rack
- xiii. Remove (2) Existing DUW for UMTS 1900 within existing rack
- xiv. Remove (1) Existing DUL within existing rack
- xv. Install (1) Proposed DC 6 (Squid) on Tower @ 52' RAD
- xvi. Install (1) Proposed .4" fiber trunk and (4) proposed .8" DC power trunk within Existing Monopole.

The installation, construction, and/or modification of equipment/facilities as described herein is subject to the issuance of a use permit and/or building permit as may be required and issued by the San Mateo County Department of Planning and Building. Permittee shall obtain all necessary governmental approvals and permits prior to commencing any improvements or modifications, and shall provide Permittor with ten (10) days written notice prior to the start of construction.

2. **Term.** Any reference to the Term in the Permit notwithstanding, the expiration date of the Permit is hereby extended to June 30, 2022.
3. **Option to Extend Term.** Permittee shall have the right to further extend the Term for one period of five (5) years beyond June 30, 2022 ("Extension Option"). If Permittee is not then in material default under the terms of the Permit as Amended, Permittee, at its sole discretion, may exercise the Extension Option, if at all, only by giving written notice to Permittor no later than September 30, 2023, but not sooner than July 1, 2023.
4. **Base Permit Fee.** Any references to the Base Permit Fee of the Permit as Amended notwithstanding, effective on the Effective Date (as defined herein), the Base Permit Fee shall increase to Five Thousand Five Hundred and NO/100 Dollars (\$5,500.00), which rate shall be subject to adjustment in accordance with Section 7C. (Base Permit Fee Adjustment) of the Permit.
5. **Notice.** Section 28 of the Permit is hereby revised to change the Permittee's and Permittor's notice addresses to the following:

6. **Effective Date; Approval.** This First Amendment shall become effective (the "Effective Date") when the County Board of Supervisors adopts a resolution authorizing the execution of this First Amendment, and this First Amendment is duly executed by the County and delivered to Permittee.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING TO THE CONTRARY CONTAINED IN THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, PERMITTOR ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT NO OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF COUNTY HAS AUTHORITY TO COMMIT COUNTY HERETO UNLESS AND UNTIL THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HAS ADOPTED A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PERMIT. THEREFORE, ANY OBLIGATIONS OR LIABILITIES OF COUNTY HEREUNDER ARE CONTINGENT UPON ADOPTION OF SUCH A RESOLUTION, AND THIS FIRST AMENDMENT SHALL BE NULL AND VOID UNLESS THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTS A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THIS FIRST AMENDMENT. APPROVAL OF THIS FIRST AMENDMENT BY ANY DEPARTMENT, COMMISSION OR AGENCY OF COUNTY SHALL NOT

BE DEEMED TO IMPLY THAT SUCH RESOLUTION WILL BE ADOPTED, NOR WILL ANY SUCH APPROVAL CREATE ANY BINDING OBLIGATIONS ON COUNTY.

7. **Counterparts.** This First Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
8. **No Further Amendments; Conflicts.** All the terms and conditions of the Permit remain in full force and effect except as expressly amended herein. The Permit as amended by this First Amendment constitutes the entire agreement between County and Permittee and may not be modified except by an instrument in writing duly executed by the parties hereto. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Permit and the terms of this First Amendment, the terms of this First Amendment shall control.

- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT US (UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT) AT (800) 337-7400, FOR UTILITY LOCATIONS, 48 HOURS BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH ANY EXCAVATION, SITE WORK OR CONSTRUCTION.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL ALL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS UNLESS SPECIFICALLY INDICATED OTHERWISE, OR WHERE LOCAL CODES OR REGULATIONS HAVE PRECEDENCE.
- ALL CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE O.C. / U.S.C.'S REQUIREMENTS REGARDING EARTHQUAKE RESISTANCE, FOR, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PILING, BEAM, BRIDGES, CEILING GRID, INTERIOR PARTITIONS, AND MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT. ALL WORK MUST COMPLY WITH LOCAL EARTHQUAKE CODES AND REGULATIONS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RELY SOLELY ON THE PLOT OF SURVEY DRAWING AND ANY SURVEYOR'S MARKINGS AT THE SITE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TRUE NORTH, AND SHALL NOTIFY THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER PRIOR TO PROCEEDING WITH THE WORK IF ANY DISCREPANCY IS FOUND BETWEEN THE VARIOUS ELEMENTS OF THE WORKING DRAWINGS AND THE TRUE NORTH ORIENTATION AS SHOWN ON THE CIVIL SURVEY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR FAILURE TO NOTIFY THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER.
- THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT ISSUING THE PERMITS SHALL BE NOTIFIED AT LEAST TWO WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK, OF AS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BY THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL HAVING JURISDICTION.
- DONOT BECAUSE OF COLLAPSE BEFORE THE PROPERTY LINES OR LEASE LINES, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- ALL EXISTING UTILITIES, FACILITIES, CONDITIONS, AND THEIR DIMENSIONS SHOWN ON THE PLAN HAVE BEEN PLOTTED FROM AVAILABLE RECORDS. THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER AND THE OWNER ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY WHATSOEVER AS TO THE SUFFICIENCY OR THE ACCURACY OF THE INFORMATION SHOWN ON THE PLANS, OR THE MANNER OF THEIR REMOVAL OR ADJUSTMENT. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING EXACT LOCATION OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND FACILITIES PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION. CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO OBTAIN FROM EACH UTILITY COMPANY DETAILED INFORMATION RELATIVE TO WORKING SCHEDULES AND METHODS OF REMOVING OR ADJUSTING EXISTING UTILITIES.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING UTILITIES, BOTH HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL, PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION. ANY DISCREPANCIES OR DOUBTS AS TO THE INTERPRETATION OF PLANS SHOULD BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER FOR RESOLUTION AND INSTRUCTION, AND NO FURTHER WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED UNTIL THE DISCREPANCY IS CHECKED AND CORRECTED BY THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER. FAILURE TO SECURE SUCH INSTRUCTION MEANS CONTRACTOR WILL HAVE WORKED AT THEIR OWN RISK AND EXPENSE.
- ALL NEW AND EXISTING UTILITY STRUCTURES ON SITE AND IN AREAS TO BE DISTURBED BY CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO FINISH ELEVATIONS PRIOR TO FINAL INSPECTION OF WORK.
- ANY DEAN AND/OR FIELD THE ENGINEERED / DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE RETURNED TO ITS ORIGINAL CONDITION PRIOR TO COMPLETION OF WORK. SIZE, LOCATION AND TYPE OF ANY UNDERGROUND UTILITIES OR IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE ACCURATELY NOTED AND PLACED ON "AS BUILT" DRAWINGS BY GENERAL CONTRACTOR, AND REFER TO THE ARCHITECT / ENGINEER AT COMPLETION OF PROJECT.
- ALL EMPLOYER EXCAVATIONS FOR THE RESTORATION OF FOUNDATIONS, UTILITIES, ETC. SHALL BE PROPERLY LAID BACK OR BROCED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CORRECT OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA) REQUIREMENTS.
- INCLUDE MISC. ITEMS PER ASIT SPECIFICATIONS

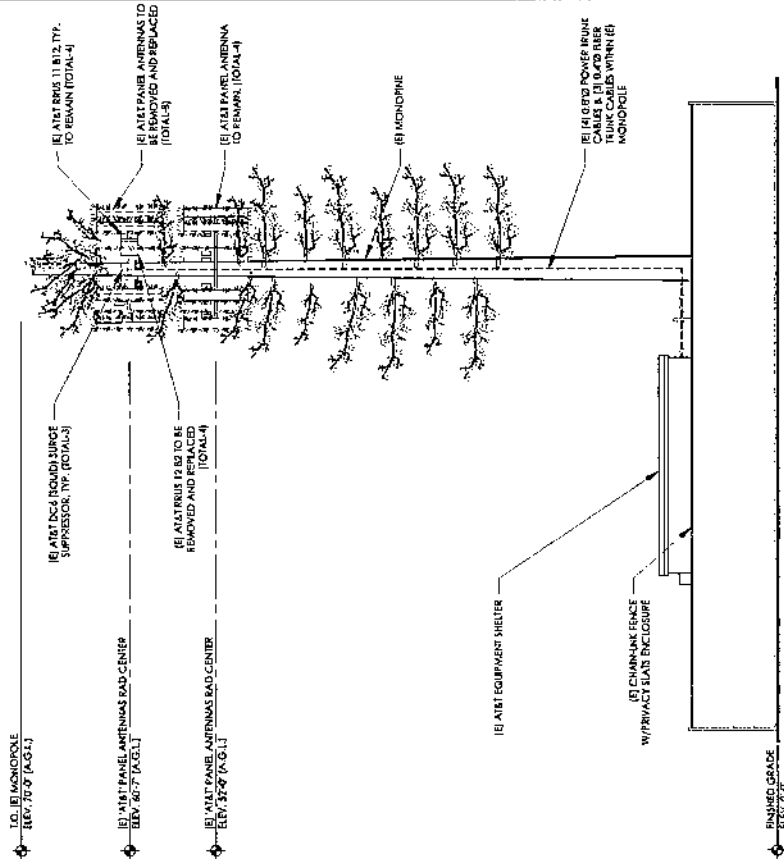
