## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REQUEST APPROVAL FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH A "PASSENGER LOADING ZONE" DURING THE SPECIFIED HOURS OF 5:00 PM TO 11:00 PM, ON EL CAMINO REAL, IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22506 et al. and Section 7.52.010 of the County Ordinance Code allows the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones and associated signs and markings in their respective jurisdictions on a state highway if the resolution or ordinance establish said restrictions are first submitted and approved in writing by the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a "Passenger Loading Zone" during the specified hours of 5:00 PM to 11:00 PM, be established as noted herein; and

WHEREAS, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking locations, were sent a notice of proposed parking restriction and majority of the responses were all in favor of the restriction; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that, The Director of Public Works is authorized to send a copy of this resolution to the Department of Transportation to establish a "Passenger Loading Zone" during specified
hours of 5:00 PM to 11:00 PM on El Camino Real (CA-82), unincorporated Redwood City; Post Mile: SM2.613 along the northerly side of El Camino Real, beginning at a point of 24 feet southeast of the intersection with East Selby Lane and continuing southeasterly for approximately 52 feet, more or less.
