RESOLUTION:

**AUTHORIZING A TIME LIMITED PARKING ZONE, DISABLED PARKING ZONES
AND PROHIBITED PARKING AFTER SPECIFIED HOURS IN THE PARKING LOT AT
2ND AVENUE AND MIDDLEFIELD ROAD, A COUNTY OPERATED PUBLIC
PARKING LOT.**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Section 22519 of the California Vehicle Code authorizes the County of San Mateo to prohibit, restrict or regulate the parking, stopping, or standing of vehicles on any off-street parking facility which the County owns or operates; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.32.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code provides that motor vehicles shall not be parked in any area which the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, designates as a no parking area during prescribed hours; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to operate off-street public parking facilities in the unincorporated North Fair Oaks area of the County, including a lot located at 2nd Avenue and Middlefield Road; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that the County impose a two hour time limit on parking in County operated public lots in North Fair Oaks and that parking be prohibited in such lots in North Fair Oaks between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with these recommendations of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that parking of all vehicles in the County owned and operated off-street parking facility located at 2nd Avenue and Middlefield Road in North Fair Oaks shall be limited to two (2) hours.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM every day, there shall be no parking in the off-street parking facility owned and operated by the County located at 2nd Avenue and Middlefield Road in North Fair Oaks.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that two Disabled Parking spaces are established at the 2nd Avenue and Middlefield Road parking lot.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director of Public Works shall procure and post appropriate signage regarding these parking restrictions.
