**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF  
JUSTICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$164,564 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE  
MEDICAL EXAMINER-CORONER OFFICE ACCREDITATION PROGRAM DURING  
THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County Coroner's Office is currently seeking accreditation through the International Association of Coroners and Medical Examiners (IACME); and

**WHEREAS**, in March 2017 the Coroner's Office received a two-year Medical Examiner-Coroner Office Accreditation Program grant from the National Institute of Justice ("NIJ") in the amount of \$164,564 (the "NIJ Grant") to assist with the IACME-accreditation; and

**WHEREAS**, the NIJ Grant will assist the Coroner's Office in complying with the recommendation of the National Commission on Forensic Science that, by 2020, all Medical Examiner-Coroner offices in the United States be accredited according to a national or international accreditation standard.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors accept the NIJ Grant in the amount of \$164,564 for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019.
