On 23 years of distinguished service to San Mateo County

WHEREAS, **Jeffrey Morino** served San Mateo County for 23 years and is retiring in March 2018 as the Deputy Chief Probation Officer of the Probation Department's Juvenile Services Division; and

WHEREAS, Jeff began his career in public service as a Group Supervisor II at the San Mateo County Juvenile Hall in 1995, was promoted to Group Supervisor III in 1996 and subsequently as an Institution Services Manager in 1997 where he became a POST certified background investigator; and

WHEREAS, Jeff became a Deputy Probation Officer in 1999 and was assigned to various units and became a vital member of collaborations such as the US Marshall's fugitive apprehension strike team, the FBI's High Technology Crimes Task Force where he became a POST certified financial and computer crimes expert and trained other law enforcement agencies throughout the nation on computer forensics and identity theft investigation techniques; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, **Jeff** was promoted to Probation Services Manager I and developed new Probation programs such as the Department's first certified evidence based cognitive engagement supervision unit, a sex offender containment model and the implementation of an evidence based risk assessment tool, Jeff was then promoted to Probation Services Manager II overseeing the Adult Services Division and then Information Technology, Hiring and Training, and in 2017 was promoted to Deputy Chief Probation Officer for the Juvenile Services Division; and

WHEREAS, during his career, **Jeff** established and developed a culture not only of social justice but compassion for Probation clients and employees through his leadership and collaboration through the Camp Glenwood redesign and the reformation of the Probation peer support team; and

WHEREAS, **Jeff** is a passionate public servant, mentor and inspiration whose dedication and professionalism is admired by all of those who have the pleasure of working with him.
