

**Attachment “A” – Proposed Parking Restriction and Public Input Summary**

Authorizing the establishment of a “No Parking” zone, on Alameda De Las Pulgas, in unincorporated West Menlo park as shown on the attached map to provide improved sight distance for motorists.

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**Location: Alameda De Las Pulgas (County Road No. 26-A) West Menlo Park**

- **Along the south side of Alameda De Las Pulgas beginning 36 feet southeast of the intersection with Clayton Drive and continuing southeasterly for approximately 70ft, more or less.**

Establish No Parking Zone.

Discussion:

The Department has evaluated the requests and determined that a No Parking Zone will benefit residents of Clayton Drive and motorists on Alameda De Las Pulgas.

Key Facts:

- Restricting parking at this location will benefit residents of Clayton Drive and motorists in the area.
- There are three objections and nineteen in support for this item.
- Supporters cite increased safety for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists.
- Two survey respondents indicated opposition to the proposed No Parking Zone but did not specify any reason for the objections.
- One respondent in opposition whose property is adjacent to and includes approximately 10 feet of proposed No Parking Zone completed the survey twice and indicated a concern over lack of available street parking. Staff believes that there is adequate parking south of the proposed No Parking Zone. If the proposed No Parking zone were adjusted to remove the section adjacent to this property the resulting space would not be large enough to accommodate a vehicle without overhanging into the adjacent driveway.

Staff Recommendations:

Time Limited Parking During Specified Hours Zones.
