WHEREAS, the City of San Carlos was incorporated in 1925 and three years later, in 1928, Archbishop Edward Hanna of San Francisco established a new Catholic parish called **Saint Charles Parish** to serve the growing number of Catholic families living there; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 1929, Father Harold Crampton celebrated the first **Saint Charles Parish** mass in the new church built on Walnut Street, followed by countless services presided over by seven successive leaders, including the current Reverend Father David Ghiorso; and

WHEREAS, **Saint Charles Parish** purchased land in 1948 on Tamarack Avenue, opening the Saint Charles School in 1950 and building the Saint Charles Rectory in 1951, to be followed by construction of the Convent in 1959 and the current Saint Charles Church dedication in 1966; and

WHEREAS, subsequent expansion of **Saint Charles Parish** included Borromeo Hall in 1994 and the re-dedication of Saint Charles Church in 2010 following a roof repair and interior renovation;

WHEREAS, **Saint Charles Parish** has been an important religious pillar in the lives of San Carlos Catholics, as well as a wonderful community partner for the entire city of San Carlos for nine decades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County does hereby recognize and commend **Saint Charles Parish** in the City of San Carlos on the celebration of its 90th Anniversary and wishes the Parish, its clergy and its many community members continued success and support.
