RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NO PARKING ZONE ON CANADA ROAD IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF BELMONT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et seq and Section 7.30.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allows the Board of Supervisors to establish no parking zones and associated signs and markings; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “No Parking” zone be established as noted herein; and,

WHEREAS, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking restrictions were notified of the date and time of this Board’s meeting when this Item will be considered; and,

WHEREAS, the comments received to date are in support of the recommended “No Parking” zone; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that that:

A “No Parking” zone be established at the following location:

- Canada Road (County Road No. 20) Redwood City

Along the east side of Canada Road commencing at the intersection of the Ralston Avenue Bike Trail and extending 50 feet northwesterly and 50 feet southeasterly, a total distance of 100 feet more or less.
