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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BUEHLER & BUEHLER
STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS TO PROVIDE ON-CALL STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING
SERVICES FOR GENERAL FACILITIES, FOR THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 26, 2018
THROUGH SEPTEMBER 26, 2021, FOR A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF
\$300,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo is authorized to engage the services of professional technical experts; and

WHEREAS, the public interest and general welfare will be served by selecting and using qualified engineers for various professional services; and

WHEREAS, a solicitation for a Request for Proposal was issued and a selection committee comprised of Department staff revised and ranked the 10 submissions received and recommended the firm providing the most favorable rates; and

WHEREAS, the structural engineering firm Buehler & Buehler Structural Engineers is qualified to provide structural engineering services on a variety of projects; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that an agreement be entered into with the firm to provide Structural Engineering Services as may be needed and under the direction of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said Agreement and has examined and approved same as to both form and content, and desires to enter into the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the agreement for Beuhler and Beuhler Structural Engineers for the term of September 26, 2018 through September 26, 2021 for an amount up to \$300,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works, or his designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current revised fiscal provisions.

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
