**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION: A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE FAIR OAKS COMMUNITY SCHOOL GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE AND SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS - NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, JUNE 6, 2019 AT 1:30 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO 60 CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the City/County Association of Governments (C/CAG) issued a competitive call for projects that integrate Safe Routes to School improvements with Green Infrastructure for stormwater management to be funded primarily by C/CAG; and

**WHEREAS**, the County submitted a grant proposal for a project at the Fair Oaks Community School, which was selected by C/CAG to receive funding; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2018, this Board adopted Resolution No. 075796, which authorized the Director of the Office of Sustainability or his/her designee to execute a funding agreement with the C/CAG for the Safe Routes to School and Green Streets Infrastructure Pilot Program (Pilot Program); and

**WHEREAS**, the funding agreement provides up to \$250,000 in C/CAG funding

for construction costs with a minimum local match of 15 percent or \$37,500.

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications dated May 10, 2019 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Fair Oaks Community School Green Infrastructure and Safe Routes to School Improvements - North Fair Oaks area, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

**WHEREAS**, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

1. The plans and specifications dated May 10, 2019, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to

be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Thursday, June 6, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to 60 calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published two times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
