















8th Largest Roll of all 58 counties in California




Roll Value per Appraisal Staff Member (\$Bs)






Assessment Roll Growth












San Mateo County A Leader in California Elections




Daily Activities in County Clerk-Recorder Division




Lowest Cost Per Capita







Once chemically preserved, the records are protected for 300 to 500 years.

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


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








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Geographic Information System (GIS)

- Esri LGIM Platform
- Foundation of Countywide GIS
- Assessor Parcel (225K parcels), Tax Rate Area (TRA) and Election precinct layers
- Web portal available to public, cities and jurisdictions in 2020

Geographic Information System (GIS) Esri LGIM Platform

Converts digital maps and data into 3D Models allowing remote:

Assessor Appraisal Valuation Modeling and determination of site-specific property characteristics

Public Works Right of Way, Centerline and Infrastructure measurements (water, sewer lines, etc.)

Public Safety Agencies – identification of safe and secure emergency access to buildings

Other GIS Layers (i.e., zoning, address, city and district boundaries, etc.)

Parcel boundary tolerances within 2.4 inches over 100 feet




