AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND ABILITY NETWORK, INC.

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this 10th day of May 2019, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO ("County") and ABILITY Network, Inc. ("Contractor");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for direct access to Medicare claim verification services on March 12, 2013, for the term of November 1, 2012 through October 31, 2015, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Agreement to extend the term of the agreement through October 31, 2020 and increase the amount by \$51,000 to an amount not to exceed \$81,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Agreement to decrease the term of the agreement to October 31, 2019 and increase the amount by \$19,000, to an amount not to exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Agreement to extend the term of the agreement through October 31, 2020 and increase the amount by \$49,000 to an amount not to exceed \$149,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 2. **Contract Term** of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall be from November 1, 2012 to October 31, 2020, unless terminated earlier by the County.

2. Section 3. Payments of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services rendered in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein and any Exhibit(s) or attachment(s) attached hereto, County shall make payment to Contractor in the manner specified herein and in Exhibit "A". In

the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination. The County reserves the right to withhold payment if the County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. Contractor reserves the right to increase the then current annual fee as specified in Revised Exhibit A (rev. 4/30/19) once annually, subject to a maximum of three percent (3%) per year. In no event shall total payment for services under this Agreement exceed ONE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$149,000).

- 3. Revised Exhibit A (12/8/15 rev.) is hereby replaced with Revised Exhibit A, (rev. 4/30/19), a copy of which is attached and hereto and incorporated into this Agreement by this reference.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the agreement dated March 12, 2013, between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect, except as expressly amended.
