#### AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA

called "County," and the Regents of the University of California, hereinafter called

"Contractor";

## $\underline{W} \underline{I} \underline{T} \underline{N} \underline{E} \underline{S} \underline{S} \underline{E} \underline{T} \underline{H}$ :

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for the purpose of providing additional agricultural education services through the Healthy Living Ambassadors of the 4H Youth Development Program to the residents of San Mateo County on July 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to increase the fiscal obligation of the contract by \$64,609 and extend the term to June 30, 2021.

# NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Section 1 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

#### 1. Exhibits and Attachments

The following exhibits and attachments are attached to this Agreement and incorporated into this Agreement by this reference:

Exhibit A Services (added, Jul 1, 2019) Revised Exhibit B-2—Payments (revised, Jul 1, 2019) Attachment I—§ 504 Compliance

1. Section 3 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

#### 3. Payments

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A. County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner

specified in revised Exhibit B-2. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS,** (\$186,409). Contractor will submit quarterly, fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,500 for the first two FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, a fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,725 for the third and fourth years FY 2017-18 and FY2018-19 and a fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,956.75 for the fifth year for FY 2019-20 and for the sixth year fixed priced invoices in the amount of \$8,195.50 for FY 2020-2021.

**1.** Section 4 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

## 4. <u>Term</u>

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2021.

2. Section Exhibit A is added to the agreement to read as follows:

## Exhibit A

In consideration of the payments set forth in revised Exhibit B2, Contractor shall provide the following services:

During the fifth and sixth years of contract term, UCCE will complete the following activities:

- I. Engage a minimum of 5 school sites across San Mateo County, with priority recruitment focusing on schools in North Fair Oaks, Redwood City, South San Francisco and Daly City in support of the County's *Community Collaborative for Children's Success* (CCCS) initiative, through the Healthy Living Ambassadors program, including:
  - Over the course of two years, enroll at least 50 teens in the Healthy Living Ambassadors program established by the UCCE
  - Over the course of two years, enroll at least 250 children ages 7-10 in the educational curricula which will be delivered by the Healthy Living Ambassadors over a 6-10 week period, the curricula may include gardenbased nutrition education or the Coordinated Approach to Child Health (CATCH) physical activity curriculum
- II. Complete an annual evaluation to assess the impact of the Healthy Living Ambassadors program on fostering policy, system, or environmental changes in afterschool program settings, focusing on the use of school gardens as part of afterschool programming. Evaluation tools will include surveys and interviews with afterschool leaders, administrators, and teens.
- III. Provide a bi-annual written report at the conclusion of program and evaluation activities to the San Mateo County Health System Director to include evaluation findings, lessons learned, number of lessons given, and participation numbers for Ambassador's, students and school sites.

**3.** Original Exhibit B-1 is replaced with Revised Exhibit B-2, (rev. Jul 1, 2019).

### Revised Exhibit B-2, (rev. Jul 1, 2019)

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor described in Exhibit A subject to the terms of the Agreement, County shall pay Contractor based on the following fee schedule and terms:

Maximum Payment Amount: The total amount that the County shall be obligated to pay for services rendered in this agreement shall not exceed ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS, (\$186,409) over the course of the contract.

<u>Method of Payment and Invoicing</u>: Upon receipt of quarterly, lump-sum, fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,500 for F Y2015-16 and FY 2016-17, a fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,725 for F Y2017-18 and FY 2018-19 and a fixed price invoices in the amount of \$7,956.75 for FY 2019-20 and \$8,195.50 for FY 2020-21. The contractor shall be paid quarterly for program costs not to exceed an amount of \$186.409. Invoices shall be submitted: October 1, January 1, April 1 and June 15th.

Invoices will not exceed the aforementioned amount without pre-approval. The PI shall submit, by separate cover, a quarterly reporting of services provided. All invoices must include the following language and a signature:
