### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “NO PARKING IN BIKE LANE” ZONE ON PORTIONS OF EDGEWOOD ROAD IN UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and section 7.30.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones that prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works recommends establishing a “No Parking in Bike Lane” zone to support the flow of both vehicular and bicycle traffic and to reduce the likelihood of pedestrian crossings near the Edgewood Park and Natural Preserve Park entrance; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking restrictions were notified of the date and time of this Board’s meeting when this Item will be considered; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

A “No Parking in Bike Lane” zone be established at the following location:

Edgewood Road (County Road No. 24) Unincorporated Redwood City

Commencing at the intersection of El Vanada Road and Edgewood Road then proceeding westerly along the northside of Edgewood Road to the intersection of Crestview Way and Edgewood Road, for a total of 1340 feet, more or less.
