ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 7.34.030 TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE REGULATING RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AND TOW- AWAY ZONES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,
ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.34.030 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code is hereby
added to read as follows:

Section 7.34.030 Residential Permit Parking and tow away Zones

No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle, whether attended or
unattended, in any area declared by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors as a
Residential Permit Parking and tow-away zone, and where appropriate signs or
markings are installed and maintained as provided in Chapter 7.28, unless said vehicle
displays a valid permit. The Director of Public Works shall cause said areas to be
marked or signs erected notifying the public that parking is prohibited during specified
hours without a valid parking permit and that vehicles without a valid permit left parked
in said areas will be towed at the owner's expense.

In the event that any officer removes a vehicle that is parked in violation of this section,
such officer shall give the notice provided for in Section 22852 et seq., of the Vehicle
Code of the State of California, and the keeper of any garage in which any such vehicle
is stored may have a lien thereon for his compensation for towage and for caring for

and keeping safe such vehicle and may satisfy such lien upon compliance with and under the conditions stated in Section 22851 of the Vehicle Code.
