THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND SERVICE LEAGUE OF SAN MATEO COUNTY

	THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, is entered into this
day of	, 2019, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter
called '	'County," and Service League of San Mateo County, hereinafter called "Contractor";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement for temporary transitional housing to formally incarcerated persons on June 30, 2016, for the term July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, for a maximum agreement amount of \$95,000 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an amendment of the Agreement to extend the term through June 30, 2018, and increase the amount by an additional \$95,000 for a maximum Agreement amount of \$190,000 (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an amendment of the Agreement to extend the term through June 30, 2019, and increase the amount by an additional \$95,000 for a maximum Agreement amount of \$285,000 (the "Second Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement a third time in order to extend the term through June 30, 2020, and increase the amount by \$95,000 for a new not to exceed amount of \$380,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 2 of the Agreement is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A3 (rev. July 23, 2019), County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B3 (rev. July 23, 2019). County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed THEE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$380,000). In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not limited to payment for work not performed as required by

this Agreement.

- Section 3 of the Agreement is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:
 Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020.
- 3. Exhibit A3 (rev. July 23, 2019) and Exhibit B3 (rev. July 23, 2019) are added to the Agreement.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the agreement dated November 21, 2017, between the County and Contractor, as amended by the First Amendment and Second Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. This Third Amendment constitutes the entire understanding of the parties hereto with respect to this subject matter herein and correctly states the rights, duties, and obligations of each party as of this document's date. Any understandings, promises, negotiations, or representations between the Parties not expressly stated in this document are not binding. All subsequent modifications of this Third Amendment shall not be effective unless set forth in writing and executed by both parties.

Exhibit A3 (rev. July 23, 2019)

Contractor shall provide the following services:

A. Transitional Supportive Housing Expansion

In coordination with the San Mateo County Probation Department, who will provide referrals, Service League of San Mateo County will:

- Provide transitional, temporary housing support and services to persons
 completing a probationary period under the direct supervision of the County's
 Probation Department (either as an AB 109 supervisee and/or Unified
 Reentry) and inmates released from the County's jail and referred by the incustody case managers, receiving supportive and rehabilitative services
 through the county's service connect program, and/or other community-based
 organizations, including those activity receiving mental health and/or
 substance abuse services.
- 2. Temporary transitional housing will be provided through the Service League's five available safe and supportive transitional homes throughout Redwood City for men and women, with a total of 24 beds.
- 3. A total of six (6) dedicated beds will be made available for this population.
- 4. Program objectives include:
 - Providing clean, safe home environments to clients (with a maximum stay of 6 months),
 - Providing opportunities for coordinated case management in direct coordination with the staff of the County's Service Connect program in the areas of education, job training, and skill-building to prepare clients for self-sufficiency,
 - Providing assistance in securing permanent housing upon completion of program, in direct coordination with staff from Service Connect.

B. Program Outcomes

Based on their experiences in serving this high-risk population through the County's former Achieve 180 program, Service League's performance measures will include:

- A total of six (6) beds will be dedicated for this population through the length of the extended contract (July 1, 2019-June 30, 2020),
- Twelve (12) clients will receive coordinated supportive services through the Service League and Service connect for the fiscal year 2019-20,
- 60 percent of clients will be employed while receiving services for the fiscal year 2019-20,
- 65 percent of clients will increase their income in the fiscal year 2019-20,
- 50 percent of clients served will be placed in permanent housing following completion of the six (6) month program for fiscal 2019-20.
