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MEASURE K: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTRAL LABOR COUCIL PARTNERSHIP TO PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT SERVICES TO SAN MATEO COUNTY FOSTER YOUTH FOR THE TERM OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2020, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$463,500

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Children and Family Services (CFS) branch's mission is to enhance the well-being of children, adults, and families by providing professional, responsive, caring, and supportive services; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2018, HSA conducted a Request for Proposals

(RFP) to identify a provider for employment and educational support services and the Central Labor Council Partnership (CLCP) was selected, because of their experience and success in providing these services; and

WHEREAS, the CLCP is a collaboration of three diverse organizations and includes the Regenerate California Innovation (RCI), ProPath, Inc., and the Central Labor Council (CLC) of Fresno, Madera, Tulare and King Counties, and the CLC is the lead agency of the partnership that will hold the agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, CLCP will provide comprehensive employment support services that will assist current and former San Mateo County foster youth, and young-adults, in identifying and achieving long term career goals that will allow them to enhance their employability leading to an increase in job opportunities, sustained employment, and self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, HSA wishes to enter into an agreement with CLCP for the term of September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020, for an amount not to exceed \$463,500; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
