**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “NO PARKING” ZONE ON  
LOYOLA AVENUE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MENLO PARK**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and Section 7.30.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish no parking zones and associated signs and markings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “No Parking” zone be established as noted herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works received a request from a resident for a parking restriction on Loyola Avenue in the unincorporated area of Menlo Park to increase sight distance for residents exiting the condominium’s driveway; and

**WHEREAS**, staff investigated the request and determined that a “No Parking” zone is warranted on Loyola Avenue and would improve visibility for the residents exiting the condominium’s driveway; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking zone location, were notified and a majority of the responses received were in favor of the parking restriction; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

A “No Parking” zone be established at the following location:

- Loyola Avenue (County Road No. 448) Unincorporated Menlo Park

Along the east side of Loyola Avenue, beginning at 464 feet northeast of the intersection with El Camino Real and continuing southwesterly for approximately 25 feet, more or less.

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
