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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AGREEMENT FOR SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - EDUCATION FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,600,209

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County has an interest in advancing the Supplemental Nutrition

Assistance Program - Education (SNAP-Ed) Initiative which provides federal funds to

promote healthy eating, physical activity, and access to nutritious foods to reduce the

incidence of chronic disease in low-income communities; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to enter into an agreement, whereby the

California Department of Public Health will provide funding to support the County's

participation in the SNAP-Ed Initiative for the period of October 1, 2019 through

September 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,209; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of the agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the amended agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

Chief of San Mateo County Health is authorized to execute an agreement with the California Department of Public Health to provide funding for the County's SNAP-Ed Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or her designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
