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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AGREEMENT FOR SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - EDUCATION FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,600,209**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the County has an interest in advancing the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program - Education (SNAP-Ed) Initiative which provides federal funds to promote healthy eating, physical activity, and access to nutritious foods to reduce the incidence of chronic disease in low-income communities; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties now wish to enter into an agreement, whereby the California Department of Public Health will provide funding to support the County's participation in the SNAP-Ed Initiative for the period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,209; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of the agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the amended agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Chief of San Mateo County Health is authorized to execute an agreement with the California Department of Public Health to provide funding for the County's SNAP-Ed Initiative.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or her designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
