RESOLUTION: A) CONSOLIDATING THE CONSOLIDATED MUNICIPAL, SCHOOL AND SPECIAL DISTRICT ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019, WITH ELECTIONS CALLED BY THE BURLINGAME ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, CABRILLO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, PORTOLA VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, REDWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, SAN CARLOS SCHOOL DISTRICT, SAN MATEO-FOSTER CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, CITY OF BRISBANE, CITY OF BURLINGAME, CITY OF SAN BRUNO, AND HIGHLANDS RECREATION DISTRICT; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO RENDER SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES IN CONJUNCTION THEREWITH

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Sections 10400 through 10418 of the Elections Code authorize the consolidation of elections that are called to be held on the same day and in or within the same territory upon the order of the governing body or bodies calling the elections, the consolidation may be ordered by the County Board of Supervisors upon request, and the consolidated election shall be held in all respects as if it were one election, with the returns being canvassed by the County's Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Section 5421 of the Education Code, and any city or district shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed by the County's Chief Elections Officer in accordance with Division 10 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Burlingame Elementary School District, Portola Valley Elementary School District, San Carlos School District, and San Mateo-Foster City School District are required to hold regularly scheduled governing board elections, and the named jurisdictions have notified the County's Chief Elections Officer of the number of seats to be elected and the relevant policies for breaking a tie vote, and the named jurisdictions are requesting an election as more candidates have filed to run for office in the named jurisdictions than there are seats available; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Highlands Recreation District is required to hold regularly scheduled governing board elections, and the named jurisdiction has notified the County's Chief Elections Officer of the number of seats to be elected and the boundaries of the district, and is requesting an election as more candidates have filed to run for office in the named jurisdiction than there are seats available; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of the Cabrillo Unified School District adopted Resolution No. 14-19, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of the Redwood City School District adopted Resolution No. 29, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of Brisbane adopted Resolution Nos. 2019-27, 2019-28, 2019-29, and 2019-30, giving notice of holding a regularly scheduled general municipal election to be held on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of electing two city council members for a term of three years each, submitting to Brisbane voters a business license tax measure, a transient occupancy tax measure, and a cannabis business license tax measure, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of Burlingame adopted Resolution No. 38-2019, giving notice of holding a regularly scheduled general municipal election to be held on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of electing two city council members for a term of five years each, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of San Bruno adopted Resolution Nos. 2019-72 and 2019-73, giving notice of holding a regularly scheduled general municipal election to be held on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of electing two city council members for a term of three years each, submitting to San Bruno voters a sales tax measure, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor; and

WHEREAS, each of the aforementioned districts and municipalities has requested their respective elections to be consolidated with the November 5, 2019, Municipal, School, and Special District Election; and WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the Municipal, School and Special District Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the County's Chief Elections Officer in conducting said election, the Burlingame Elementary School District, Cabrillo Unified School District, Portola Valley Elementary School District, Redwood City School District, San Carlos School District, San Mateo-Foster City School District, City of Brisbane, City of Burlingame, City of San Bruno, and Highlands Recreation District will, as required by law, enter into separate agreements with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that (A) the November 5, 2019 Consolidated Municipal, School and Special District Election is hereby consolidated with the above-named local elections duly called by their respective governing bodies; and (B) the County's Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services in conjunction therewith.
