

Attachment “A”–Proposed Parking Restriction and Public Input Summary

Adopt a resolution authorizing the establishment of a “No Parking Zone”, on F Street, in Unincorporated Colma for a total of approximately 70 feet as seen on the map below. The No Parking Zone is needed to allow large chemical trucks to safely access SFPUC well stations.

Discussion:

The Department has evaluated the request and determined that the No Parking Zones are needed to give chemical delivery trucks access to SFPUC well stations.

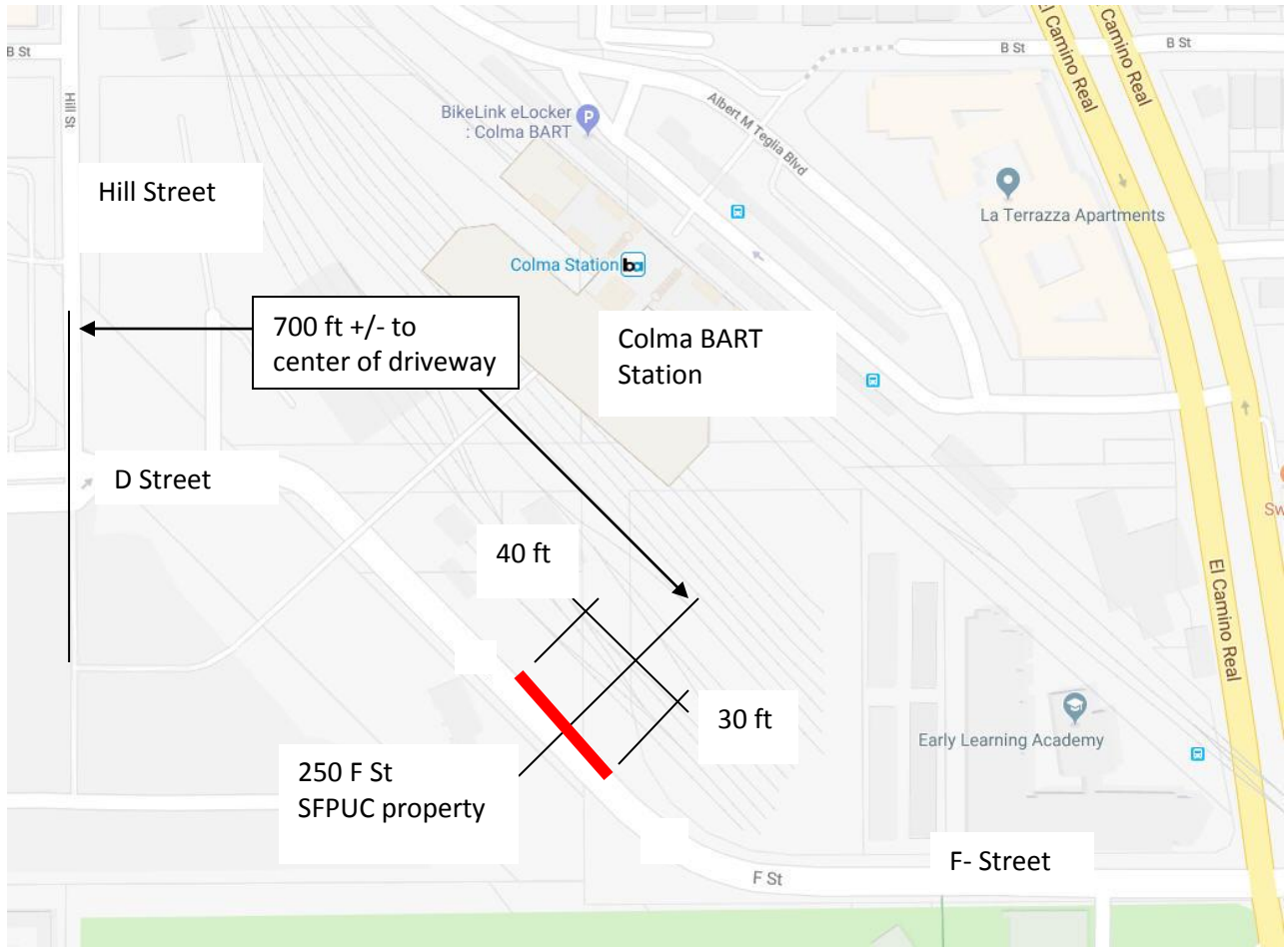
KeyFacts:

- A representative of the SFPUC requested the No Parking Zones because delivery trucks did not have turning radius clearance to the driveway of 250 F street when vehicles were parked adjacent to the driveway approach.
- Delivery trucks bringing water treatment chemicals to the SFPUC well stations can exceed 60 feet in length.
- There were no responses from the property owners survey
- Due to the proximity to the Colma BART station, the Department posted the survey on A-frames at the location of the No Parking Zones in addition to mailing the survey to all property owners within 300 feet.

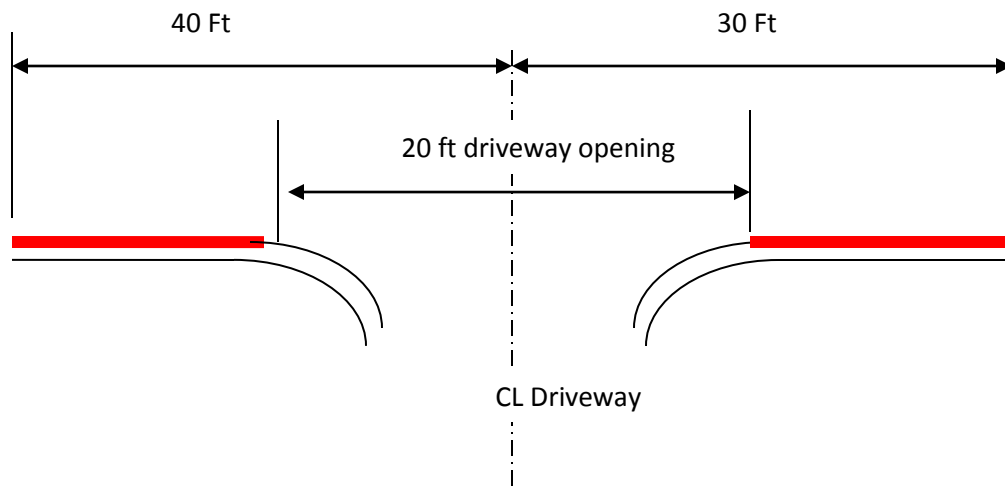
Staff Recommendations:
