WHEREAS, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office "Community Alliance to Revitalize Our Neighborhoods" Program (CARON) is celebrating two decades of service to the community; and

WHEREAS, CARON's mission is to engage the immigrant communities and long-term residents alike to cultivate trust and collaboration between them and law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, CARON empowers families with education, knowledge, and resources through community academies, which include educating the public on gang and drug prevention, immigration, domestic violence, bullying, parenting and communication; and

WHEREAS, CARON community engagement efforts, including its community dialogues and workshops, have aided residents in gaining housing, adjusting immigration status, and accessing mental health services; and
