Flood Preparedness Week

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources, Federal Emergency Management Agency, and National Weather Service have designated the week of October 19-26, 2019 as California Flood Preparedness Week across the State; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo recognizes the significant public safety threat that flooding poses to the population, assets, and economy of the County, and the County of San Mateo has endured multiple flood disasters causing public hardship, millions of dollars in property damage, and loss of economic commerce; and;

WHEREAS, California Flood Preparedness Week will be held between October 19-26, 2019, and local, state, and federal agencies will work together to inform the public of the importance of planning for flooding, to build and sustain statewide preparedness, and to enhance flood readiness; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby designates the week of October 19-26, 2019, as Flood Preparedness Week and encourages public awareness of local flood disasters and preparedness.
