North Coast County Water District 75th
Anniversary

WHEREAS, the voters created the **North Coast County Water District** on August 8, 1944, to provide high quality drinking water and reliable water service; and

WHEREAS, in the 1940s there were numerous wells scattered across the area before the community obtained its water from the Hetch Hetchy system; and

WHEREAS, in 1980 an attempted forced merger with the City of Pacifica was defeated with both the North Coast County Water District and City proclaiming "if it ain't broke, don't fix it"; and

WHEREAS, when the **North Coast County Water District** was formed there were about 700 connections, growing to 11,000 by 1994 when the District turned 50, and today at 75 there are approximately 13,000 customers; and

WHEREAS, the North Coast County Water District has been recognized as a high-performing special district, providing potable drinking water and recycled water through a complex system of storage tanks, pump and pressure reducing stations and 132 miles of pipelines; and

WHEREAS, with a committed Board of Directors and dedicated staff, the North Coast County Water District has rigorously abided its slogan of "Safe Drinking Water is our Business," ensuring its continued bright future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors honors and recognizes the accomplishments of the **North Coast County Water District**, its current and previous Boards, General Managers and District Staff, upon its 75th Anniversary, and encourages the greater community to celebrate with the District on Sunday, October 13, 2019, at the District offices located at 2400 Francisco Boulevard in Pacifica.
