WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo values all of its residents regardless of whom they love, how they worship, how they look, their abilities or how they vote; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo promotes safety, security and equal protection of constitutional and human rights; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo rejects racist, xenophobic, sexist, homophobic, Islamaphobic and other bigoted views;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, State of California, hereby designates November 17-23 as **United Against Hate Week** in San Mateo County. The Board hereby encourages all to take action to stop hate, bullying and bias in direct response to the sharp rise of hate incidents in the United States.
