**WHEREAS**, **United Against Hate Week** was started by Bay Area civic leaders in 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo wants to assure its residents and visitors that our community celebrates diversity and inclusion; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo rejects hatred, prejudice, racism, bigotry, bullying or violence in any manner toward any individual regardless of race, ethnicity, disability, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, socioeconomic status, immigration status or country of origin; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo rejects efforts to intimidate, threaten or marginalize any members of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo values all of its residents regardless of whom they love, how they worship, how they look, their abilities or how they vote; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo promotes safety, security and equal protection of constitutional and human rights; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo rejects racist, xenophobic, sexist, homophobic, Islamophobic and other bigoted views;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, State of California, hereby designates November 17-23 as **United Against Hate Week** in San Mateo County. The Board hereby encourages all to take action to stop hate, bullying and bias in direct response to the sharp rise of hate incidents in the United States.
