35th Annual Portola Elementary School Hike to Sweeney Ridge

WHEREAS, PORTOLA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL and San Mateo County in 2019 is commemorating the Two Hundred and Fiftieth Anniversary of Spanish explorer Gaspar de Portola’s discovery of San Francisco Bay, from Sweeney Ridge in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, PORTOLA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL and the County have embarked on projects to recognize the historic event and pay tribute to the Ohlone people who were already here for centuries and provided sensitive stewardship on the Peninsula’s natural resources; and

WHEREAS, PORTOLA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL in San Bruno is named for Gaspar de Portola; and

WHEREAS, For 35 years, educator Mike Casey has been leading the entire Portola Elementary School student body on an annual hike to Sweeney Ridge to acknowledge the important history of this place; and
