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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE REGENTS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA HIGH
INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA'S PREVENTION INITIATIVE, FOR A TERM
COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Northern California High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NC HIDTA) created the Prevention Initiative to facilitate collaboration between law enforcement, local and state public health agencies, the California National Guard Counterdrug Task Force Program, the Californians for Drug Free Youth, and Community Based Organizations; and

WHEREAS, The Regents of the University of California submitted a federal grant application under the FY 2018 Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-based Program that included funds for the NC HIDTA's Prevention Initiative; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2018, The Regents of the University of California was awarded \$999,175 from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs in support of the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Program; and

WHEREAS, of the \$999,175, The Regents of the University of California awarded the NC HIDTA's Prevention Initiative \$70,000 to improve collaboration,

information sharing and strategic decision-making of regulatory and law enforcement agencies and public health officials to address prescription drug and opioid misuse, save lives, and reduce crime; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the agreement with The Regents of the University of California and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the same; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement with The Regents of the University of California for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than 10% of the grant (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
