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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) AN AGREEMENT WITH ABODE TO PROVIDE RAPID RE-HOUSING SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF DECEMBER 3, 2019 TO JUNE 30, 2021 AND A TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT OF \$760,000; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO SAID AGREEMENT WHICH MODIFY THE COUNTY'S MAXIMUM FISCAL OBLIGATION BY NO MORE THAN \$100,000 (IN AGGREGATE) DURING THE SAME TERM FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPENDING HOMELESS EMERGENCY AID PROGRAM FUNDS BY JUNE 30, 2021 AS MANDATED BY HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 50214 AND 50215

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in close collaboration with many County and community partners, the Human Services Agency (HSA) coordinates homeless services throughout the County of San Mateo, and serves as the lead agency in the County for the Homeless Continuum of Care (CoC); and

WHEREAS, HSA, as the lead CoC agency, is the administrator of the \$4,933,138.71 in Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) one-time block grant funding, provided by the State of California's Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency (BCSH), to address the emergency needs of homeless individuals and individuals at imminent risk of homelessness by providing services such as rapid rehousing (RRH), rental assistance or subsidies, capital improvement to shelter facilities, and services for youth experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2019, HSA conducted a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify providers for homeless services and Abode Services (Abode) was awarded to

provide RRH services tailored to serve both the general homeless population, and to households (individuals/families) whose primary nighttime residence is in a vehicle; and

WHEREAS, HSA requests to enter into an agreement with Abode to provide RRH program services for the term of December 3, 2019 to June 30, 2021, and a total obligation amount of \$760,000; and

WHEREAS, Abode will provide rapid re-housing services including housing locator services, comprehensive case management, and financial assistance tailored to meet the individual needs of each of the populations, the general homeless and households living in vehicles, to help both populations exit homelessness and promote housing stability/permanency; and

WHEREAS, there Board has approved the agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to

execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of
this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$100,000 (in aggregate) during the same term for the purpose of expending Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) funds by June 30, 2021 as mandated by Health and Safety Code Sections 50214 and 50215, and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
