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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PLACEMAKERS, INC. TO DEVELOP AND OPERATE A BUILDING MATERIALS SALVAGE, RECOVERY, EDUCATION, AND RESALE CENTER FOR THE TERM OF JANUARY 7, 2020 TO JANUARY 6, 2023 FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Office of Sustainability (OOS) collaborates with construction contractors and homeowners to encourage deconstruction and reuse of materials from demolition and construction projects; and

WHEREAS, the OOS wishes to contract with an organization to develop and operate a building materials salvage, recovery, education, and resale center (Salvage Center) for residents and businesses to donate and/or purchase salvaged building materials; and

WHEREAS, in July 2019, the OOS issued a Request for Proposals for procuring these services and received three proposals, of which one was screened for an interview; and

WHEREAS, PlaceMakers, Inc. was subsequently selected as the preferred vendor for these services on the basis of: the responsiveness of their proposal; the cost-effectiveness of their proposal; and their extensive experience in the field of deconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the Salvage Center will promote the reuse of building materials, thereby reducing the amount of waste disposed of in landfills and reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement with PlaceMakers, Inc. and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Office of Sustainability, or the Director's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract terms and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
