RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A 20-FOOT “NO PARKING ZONE DURING SPECIFIED HOURS” FROM 7:00 AM TO 9:00 AM AND FROM 2:00 PM TO 4:00 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, ON FAIR OAKS AVENUE IN UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and Section 7.32.010 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones and associated signs and markings in their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (Department) received a request from the Sheriff’s Department for a 20-foot no parking zone during limited hours on Fair Oaks Avenue to better allow for pick up and drop off of school children utilizing public transportation, as well as provide better sight distance conditions at the intersection of Fair Oaks Avenue and Barron Avenue; and

WHEREAS, property owners on adjacent blocks within 300 feet from the proposed parking zone locations were notified and the Department did not receive any notices of support or objections to this proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works concurs with the recommendation that a 20-foot “No Parking Zone During Specified Hours,” from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday be established at the following location:

727 Barron Avenue, Unincorporated Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. A “No Parking Zone During Specified Hours”, shall begin approximately 30 feet from the centerline of Barron Avenue traveling northwest, on the north side of Fair Oaks Avenue (County Road No.1416B), for 20 feet, more or less.
