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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ARSENIO ORTEGA FOR "ON-CALL" ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$300,000 FOR A NEW NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$600,000, AND EXTENDING THE TERM FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE YEARS TO FEBRUARY 28, 2023

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2017, this Board of Supervisors did authorize the Department of Public Works to engage the services of professional technical experts; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution No. 075200 the County of San Mateo executed an agreement with electrical engineering firm Arsenio Ortega for \$300,000, with a three-year term from March 1, 2017 through February 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the public interest and general welfare will be served by extending the term of the agreement with this qualified electrical engineering professional firm to continue work on existing on-going projects; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the agreement to increase the amount by \$300,000 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$600,000, and extend the term three years, through February 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the parties will utilize the updated billing rates as presented by the Contractor for the duration of the new term, which the Department has determined to be consistent with market rates; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the amendment to this respective agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into said amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorize Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Arsenio Ortega, increasing the amount by \$300,000 to a new not-to-exceed amount of \$600,000, and extending the term through February 28, 2023, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director of Public Works, or designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments that modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
